I just got off the phone with Mbirima who is now ministering in Baraka, Congo. He is making disciples of two former Muslim young men - Saddam and Jaffari, and holding a Discovery Bible Study with four Muslim fishermen. Just today he was near the local mosque and a young muslim woman approached him asking: "Why do you Christians believe Jesus is God?" In the wisdom of the Lord Mbirima asked, "Why, when you Muslims are sick do you secretly come to Christians for prayer for healing?" She said: "Only God can heal." Mbirima responded, "And we pray in the name of Jesus who is able to heal because he is God." She was running a small shop there near the mosque and would run back and forth to hear what Mbirima was saying while trying to run her store. He said that she stopped arguing and began to listen intently. God is moving.
